

How To Use Your Red Card



Step 1: Read through your rights. Try to memorize them!



Step 2: Show or give your red card to the immigration agent.

Your goal is to show the side that says, "I do not wish to speak with you" without allowing an agent entrance. *This side of the card will always be in English.*

- Slide it under the door.
- Show it through a window.
- Drop it through your door's mail slot or doggy door.
- Etc.

Step 3: Report your interaction to a rapid response network.
